1. September 12/13, 2019 Haiku Prompt - Margarita Engle (p. 5)

road trip with puppies
just one whiff of forest air
delivers wildness

Use this haiku to create your own piece of writing. It can include visuals (like a comic), be a short story, include some non-fiction elements or be completely from your imagination.

2. September 25/26, 2019 Written Prompt - Adam Gidwitz (p. 197)

Write an encyclopedia entry (6+ sentences) about an undiscovered animal. Include: where it lives, what it eats, its personality, habits, if it's good as a pet, and any other relevant information. Include an image (picture, drawing, sketch, etc.) of some kind in your encyclopedia entry.

3. March 3, 2020 Visual Prompt - Sophie Blackall (p. 59)

Write a **multi-paragraph (minimum 4) short creative story** based on what you see in the image.

Be sure to include an **introduction** (who are the characters, what is the setting, what's happening?), the **body** of the story (where the plot/conflict happens), and a **conclusion** (wrap up your story with an ending that fits).

Can be **first person** (I, me, my) or **third person** (he, she, they) Point of View.

Can include **dialogue**. Or not. Your choice.

If you're not sure where to begin, consider:

Who is this woman? Who is this fish? Where are they? (setting = place & time)

What is the relationship between the woman and the fish? How did they get to this point? Is this the beginning, middle, or end of their story? What is the conflict?
